DISCOUNTS for Pre-Entries! Entries will be taken up to and during the day of the show. Fee for each class entered before April 10th is \$8. Fees for entries postmarked after April 10th will be \$10 per class. Classes added during the show must be done at least two classes in advance.

Classes may be combined, split, or cancelled by show management depending upon entries. For questions regarding show or class schedule, call Catherine at (541) 312-8332 or email oregongold@hotmail.com.

Ribbons will be given (1st thru 6th) in most classes. Special awards will be given to all Challenge class winners, and Breed Class winners. Entry into "Challenge" classes is automatic and there is no additional cost.

Unless otherwise designated as Haflinger or Fjord, classes are open to all equine breeds. Classes designated as such Breed Classes are open to purebreds only.

English & Western **jackpot classes** 1st place gets 50%, 2nd place gets 30%, 3rd place gets 10% of entry fee for class. **High Point Awards** are based on a single horse and rider combination and will be given for the following categories: On Saturday- High Point Fjord, High Point Haflinger, High Point Jr. Fjord or Haflinger Handler (13 & Under), High Point Youth Fjord or Haflinger Handler (14 – 17) . We also have a High Point Open 17 and under, High Point Open 18 and over division.

On Sunday-High Point Driven Fjord, High Point Driven Haflinger and High Point Open Driving. Classes marked with an asterisk (*) on the class list are not counted toward high point awards.

Stalls are available at \$18 per night; bedding is available at fair market value TBD. Please send stall fees with entry. Camping is available on the grounds in the new state-of-the-art RV campground: \$22 / \$35 per night. Please send camping fees with entry. Nearby overnight accommodations are available at Super 8 (541-548-8881) and Comfort Suites (541-504-8900). We recommend early reservations due to active local event schedule.

2011 OREGON GOLD OPEN HORSE SHOW RULES

In the interest of safety, bridles shall not be removed from any animal while it is hitched to a vehicle. <u>Removal of bridles from hitched animals will result in immediate dismissal from the show grounds.</u>

Proper attire is requested for all Pleasure Driving classes (i.e. whips, hats, gloves, and driving aprons). A proper driving whip in hand is REQUIRED for ALL driving classes. **Cavessons are required** on all driving bridles. Side checks are permitted. Pneumatic tires are allowed on driving vehicles.

Drivers 14 years & under MUST have an **adult** in the vehicle with them **at all times** while hitched.

Any animal under 14.3 hands will be considered a **pony**; any animal 14.3 hands and over, a horse. *However, small breeds of horses such as Arabian, Morgan, Icelandic, Haflinger, or Fjord may choose to compete as a horse regardless of size, but must remain in the chosen division for the entire show and may not cross enter.* Very Small Equines (VSE) are under 39 inches. For the purposes of this show, a horse's **age is determined by year of birth**. (i.e., if your horse will turn 3 at any point this year, he or she is considered 3 for this show.) A **Green Horse, Novice Rider, Novice Driver** shall not have won more than 2 firsts in the division (Western, English, Trail or Pleasure Driving) in which it is entered.

Appropriate clothing required in all classes. Boots are mandatory in riding classes. Appropriate helmets are required for all English classes, ASTM/SEI approved helmets are required for all persons 17 years & under whether riding, driving or riding as a passenger in any horse drawn vehicle. ASTM/SEI approved safety helmets are encouraged in all riding classes, including Western. Long sleeves required for Western classes. Horses 6 and over MUST be in an appropriate curb bit for Western classes. No training aids (martingales, side reins, tie-downs, etc.) are allowed in the arena.

Any **dogs** brought onto the show grounds must be kept leashed at all times. Dogs, which cause problems by way of behavior or noise, may be required to be removed from the grounds.

Attendance at this event, whether as a spectator or participant, gives your consent for images to be used by the photographer, Stacy Judd, for commercial purposes.

You or your company may sponsor classes or awards at Oregon Gold for as little as \$25. Contact oregongold@hotmail.com. **Food and drink** will be available for purchase on the grounds during the show.

Any actions against a horse by a competitor or an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by the judge, steward, or other show official, in the show ring or anywhere on the grounds may be punished by official warning or elimination from the class and or show and all entry fees are then forfeited. The show judge may excuse from any class any entry deemed unfit, lame, unsound, unmanageable, etc.

Any decision made by the Judge is final!
