- c. Babylon is the capital of Babylonia
- d. Babylonians built roads

- b. They are skilled warriors
- c. Attack their enemies first
- d. By 650 BC Assyria had conquered a large empire; across the Fertile

 - a. They invented the battering ram
 - They have a library, which held information about life in early
