

Decal Removal and Application Guidelines

You will need:

Hair dryer, alcohol or goo gone, cotton, sharp scissors, rag

- 1- With a blow-dryer on highest setting, heat up the narrow end of the decal until it begins to release when gently lifted. Continue directing heat on the decal and slowly remove from helmet. Be careful not to overheat, as the adhesive will remain mostly on the helmet.
- 2- Remove adhesive residue by rubbing with finger (it will roll into a ball)
Very sparingly, you may use a cotton ball, slightly dampened with alcohol or goo gone to remove the trace residue. The alcohol will dull the helmet, so be careful.
- 3- Clean the helmet with soap and water, Dry thoroughly.
- 4- Careful cut the decals to separate the pair. If you do this, it makes it easier to place them.
- 5- To align the decals evenly, you may use the holes on the top of the helmet and the face mask.
- 6- Apply the decals from the front of the helmet towards the back. The front is the taller (wider) part of the logo. It is easier to keep air bubbles out by using a cloth to rub them out as you carefully apply from the front to the back.
