Acts 26:24-29

Neglect/Put-Off

This little word, “**Neglect**”, is used, in our New Testament Bibles, three (3) times. Each time this word is used, it is used to describe an event that could really be a big problem for anyone who “**Neglects or Puts-Off**” to do what the Holy Scripture says.

1 Here, if we “**Neglect**”, we will get into real trouble with the Church!

Matthew 18:16-17 KJV But if he will not hear *thee*, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. (17) And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell *it* unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

2 Here, if we “**Neglect**”, we will have problems with being true to the Church

1 Timothy 4:12-16 KJV Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. (13) Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. (14) Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. (15) Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. (16) Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.

3 Here, if we “**Neglect - (Put-Off)**”, we won’t have problems with the Church, we won’t even be a part of the Church, in fact, we will lose our souls for eternity!

Hebrews 2:1-3 KJV Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let *them* slip. (2) For if the word spoken by angels was steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompense of reward; (3) How shall we escape, if we neglect - (Put-Off) so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard *him*;

Acts 26:24-29 KJV And as he thus spake for himself, Festus said with a loud voice, Paul, thou art beside thyself; much learning doth make thee mad. But he said, I am not mad, most noble Festus; but speak forth the words of truth and soberness. For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner. King Agrippa, believest thou the prophets? I know that thou believest. **Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian. And Paul said, I would to God, that not only thou, but also all that hear me this day, were both almost, and altogether such as I am, except these bonds.**



1 Thessalonians 5:24 KJV Faithful *is* he that calleth you, who also will do *it*.
