Comeliness

Isaiah 53:2 KJV For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor **comeliness**; and when we shall see him, *there is* no beauty that we should desire him.

Today's Word is Comeliness. It is use 5 times in the entire Word of God, 4 times in the Old Testament and 1 time in the New Testament. It means almost the same in every place it is used in our Bibles. In essence, the splendor: - beauty, comeliness, excellency, glorious, glory, goodly, honour, majesty of a thing or person. Our Lord, while he walked here on earth, was said in Isaiah 53:2, not to have outward beauty, that we should desire Him. (**as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him**)

Jesus, who is said to be the bodily representation of the Old Testament Wilderness Tabernacle, in **Exodus 25:8 KJV**, and like the Wilderness Tabernacle, whose outward appearances was drab (from outside the court of the Gentiles), likewise, from Isaiah 53:2, our Savior had no outward beauty. (**when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him**). Any value, that we could attach ourselves to, had to be the value of His literal fulfillment of the Living Word of our Most High God. Every syllable of God's Holy Word was and is to be fulfilled by the Anointed One, Jesus The Christ of God. John the Baptist, saw Jesus and said:

John 1:29 KJV The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

If you are waiting for some brilliant flash of light or some modern day wonder boy Jesus, before you turn to God, then I am afraid that you will die in your sins. Our faith should not rest is some artist rendition of a beautiful Jesus, but our faith must find a resting place in Jesus, the God Man and the finished work of His blood soaked cross. Our salvation is a done deal, not a deal, waiting to be done. Our salvation was finished 2000 years ago when Jesus said:

John 17:3-5 KJV **And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. (4) I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. (5) And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

John 19:30 KJV When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, **It is finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

During His time on Earth, Jesus said something to the unbelievers of His day, It is very easy to understand. And it means the same to everyone of us today.

Luke 13:5 KJV **I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.**

John 8:23-24 KJV And he said unto them, **Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world. (24) I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.**

Anyone can be saved by turning from their sin to Jesus and His finished Work on the cross. **Plus Nothing and Minus Nothing** Jesus will not share His Glory with you or any other mere mortal. He will not share His Lordship with Hinduism, Islamism, or any other false god's. Jesus Said:
