

## All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6 KJV

Dear friends, this is one of my favorite Bible verses. God uses this verse of Scripture to describe you and I prior to our being born again or saved. There are two words here that always stood out to me, the words, "**like Sheep**". Gods describes, in some detail, what He sees us like before we come to Him to be saved.
