

Mark 1:14-18 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, (15) And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. (16) Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. (17) And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become "*fishers of men*". (18) And straightway they forsook their nets, and followed him.



Being a "Fisher of Men" is often one the most lowest paid, and un-appreciated jobs that you will ever do. But the benefits are literally, out of this world. For example, our medical provisions are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Our Doctor is the Great Physician. He has never lost anyone who went to Him in faith. All this is as close as a humble, kneeling position. Our security plan covers all ages, not just the elderly — Jesus said I will never leave you — and lo, I will go with thee into all the world. We even have a food and clothing plan, He said that He clothed the Grass of the field, arrayed all of the pretty flowers and fed the little birds, and said about this, that we are even worth more than these to Him. He said if we would put Him first, that He would see to it that all of our earthly needs were met. He also talked about us living longer lives. He said that who-so-ever believes on Him shall never die. He even has plans to promote his best workers:

Daniel 12:3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Now all of this would seem like something that is to good to be true. And it would be, except that God cannot lie, and the Bible is chuck full of these kind of God promises. If you have need in your life, then take care of God's business first. You can even do this in your own home.

1 Kings 17:10-16 So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman *was* there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink. (11) And as she was going to fetch *it*, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand. (12) And she said, *As* the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I *am* gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die. (13) And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go *and* do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring *it* unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son. (14) For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day *that* the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth. (15) And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat *many* days. (16) *And* the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah.



God's business product is souls for heaven. He spends much time training men and women on just how to win souls for Jesus. God's **main desire is that no soul should be lost**. And, when He does save someone, <u>He does not lose them</u>.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, <u>not</u> <u>willing that any should perish</u>, but that all should come to repentance.

John 17:10-12 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. (11) And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*. (12) While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
