The little word "hear" is a well used word and in at least 6 places, it is an **EXTREMELY** important word! It is found 550 times in the KJV. It is found 405 times in the Old Teastament and 145 times in the New Testament. It is defined in Strong's Greek Dictionary, by reference number, G191 and is as follows: — Pronounced — *ak-oo'-o Its meaning* — A primary verb; <u>to hear</u> (in various senses): - *give* (in the) *audience* (of), *come* (to the ears), ([shall]) *hear* (-er, -ken), *be noised, be reported, understand.*

◆ Matthew 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, <u>This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased;</u> hear (G191) ye him.

- Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, <u>This is my beloved Son: hear (G191) him.</u>
- Luke 9:35 And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, <u>This is my beloved Son: hear</u> (G191) <u>him.</u>
- John 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and <u>they</u> shall hear (G191) my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.
- ◆ John 10:27 <u>My sheep hear (G191) my voice</u>, and I know them, and they follow me:
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: <u>if any man hear (G191) my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him</u>, and will sup with him, and he with me.

am going on 69, but I can still remember hearing my Daddy say, "Did you hear me when I called for you?" The meaning, that was forcefully embedded into my spirit was, "Why didn't you come when I called you?" *Kids of my day understood that to hear their Daddy was to obey their Daddy!*

When was the last time that your heard your Heavenly Daddy? <u>To hear our Heavenly Daddy is to</u> obey our <u>Heavenly Daddy!</u>

<u>There are — 3 —very simple things involved with hearing God.</u>

1. <u>To Hear God Means That We Must Listen To God.</u>

In the first 3 Scripture references, Our Heavenly Father tells Jesus' Disciples to stop planning and talking, and just listen to His Son Jesus! Do you know that most Christian plan and talk way too much. We are told to just be quiet and listen!

2. <u>To Hear God Means That We Must Be In Fellowship With God.</u>

After I was saved, my first Pastor used to say that fellowship means, "Two fellows in the same ship". This is what is being said in the last 3 Scripture references.

3. <u>To Hear</u> God Means That <u>We Must Obey God.</u>

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: <u>if any man hear</u> (G191) <u>my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him</u>, and will sup with him, and he with me.

The main extent in obeying God, means that we throw open the door of our hearts to Him. <u>Obeying Jesus is to believe Jesus!</u> <u>To believe Jesus is</u> <u>to do what He says.</u>

John 6:28-29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? (29) Jesus answered and said unto them, **This is the work of God**, **that ye believe on him whom he hath sent**.
