<u>Mark 3:31-35</u> There came then his brethren and his mother, and, standing without, sent unto him, calling him. (32) And the multitude sat about him, and they said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren without seek for thee. (33) And he answered them, saying, Who is my mother, or my brethren? (34) And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren! (35) <u>For who-</u> <u>soever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sis-</u> <u>ter, and mother.</u>



**Ephesians 6:1-6** Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. (2) Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) (3) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. (4) And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (5) Servants, be obedient to them that are *your* masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; (6) Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;

**<u>1 John 2:16-17</u>** For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes,

and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. (17) And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: <u>but he that doeth</u> <u>the will of God abideth for</u> ever.

Luke 11:2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
