KNOWING JESUS

If You Died
Today

Heaven?

Philippians 3:7-14

- (7) But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.
(This is called dying to your own ways, abilities, means, and totally depending on the name and power of Jesus)
- (8) Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ,
(What we have done and can do is like a manure pile when compared to Our Jesus)
- (9) And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:
(Our righteousness is like a pile of filthy rags, when compared to the work of Jesus)
- (10) That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;
(To really Know Jesus is to have a very close personal relationship with Him, very much like two married people. They feel each others pain. The longer that they are together, the more a like that they become. A close married couple can not survive without each other.)
- (11) If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.
(A resurrected Christian is a Christian that is just like Jesus!)
- (12) Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
(Our lives have been bought and paid for by the blood of Jesus— we have been redeemed and will be made like Jesus at His second coming)
- (13) Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
(A winning walk with Jesus is a walk that is not satisfied until it is all that it can be for Jesus. If we dwell on passed victories or past failures, we will never be able to live a ever growing life for Jesus. Everyday is a new day in Jesus. Each day is filled with His promises. Only by reaching for the future promises of Jesus—will we accomplish our life's work.)
- (14) I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.
(Each of us has his our her own high calling, Some for one thing, and some for another. You cannot accomplish my calling and neither can I reach your calling. Each work for Jesus is just as important as others are. There are no Big "I's" or little "you's". Each is very important.)
