

His Word of the day is another **Comforter**. It is from **"John 14:16"**. I think that this a most wonderful thing, that God would take time out of eternity to be in charge of this little writing and teaching effort. What a huge and powerful person that He is, yet, He would speak and help people like you and me. You will never be able to convince me, that God doesn't love us. Even the very hairs on our heads are numbered! Today's Word is **"Comforter"**. <u>Something or someone who comforts!</u>



John 14:16-17 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another <u>Comforter</u>, that he may abide with you for ever; (17) *Even* the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. (18) I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

As a kid from Ohio, I remember sleeping, during the cold winter months, in the upstairs of our old farm house. We had coal stoves for heat, but where my brother and I slept, it was often pretty cool. My Mother would put, what she called comforters, upon us. They were heavy types of blankets, that were quilted and thick. I remembered waking up under that wonderful, warm comforter and finding a layer of ice in my water glass next to my bed. Thank God for good mothers, good daddies and good comforters.

I have lived long enough to realize that there has always been someone in the background of my life, protecting me from harm, wooing me towards Jesus, sealing me into Himself and leading me safely to my eternal home.

Ephesians 1:13 KJV In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, <u>ye were sealed</u> with that holy Spirit of promise, **Ephesians 4:30 KJV** And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby <u>ye are sealed</u> unto the day of redemption.

Jesus said that He would send us <u>another</u> Comforter. That means that there had to be a first Comforter! <u>Je</u><u>sus was the first Comforter</u>. While Jesus was on Earth, He comforted his followers, feeding then, providing for them, teaching them and keeping them from harm!

John 17:12-13 KJV While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. (13) And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

Now, according to our main verse today, Jesus said that He would send us <u>another</u> Comforter. A second Comforter, who, like Himself, would take care of God's little children, - <u>You and me</u>. He will teach us, feed us, cloth us, protect us and deliver us safely home. I am so glad to be a kid once again, just to sit on my Heaven Father's (Daddy's) lap and leave all the heavy lifting up to him.

Jude 1:24-25 KJV Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, (25) To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

Romans 8:14-15 KJV For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. (15) For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, **Abba**, **Father**. (interpreted DADDY)

Galatians 4:4-6 KJV But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, (5) To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. (6) And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. (interpreted DADDY)
