John 3:16 For God *so loved* the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

God <u>So Loved</u> The World

God so loved the World. This says it all. The whole purpose of this world has, is and shall be so that God can demonstrate His love and provide for us. It sounds so simple, but that is exactly God's Plan — God just wants to love and provide for us.

1 John 4:10 And this is love, not that we had love for God, but that he had love for us, and sent his Son to be an offering for our sins. (Basic English Version)

Isn't that what happens when we love somebody? We just want to give of our selves and provide for their needs. But, the difference here is that God is absolute in Holiness and demands and has made provision for each one of us.

1 Peter 1:15-16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; (16) Because it is written, **Be ye holy; for I am holy**. **(KJV)**

Christians are told to be like or imitate their Heavenly Father

1 Peter 2:15-21 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: (16) As free, and not using *your* liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. (17) Honour all *men.* Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king. (18) Servants, *be* subject to *your* masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. (19) For this *is* thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully. (20) For what glory *is it*, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer *for it*, ye take it patiently, this *is* acceptable with God. (21) For even hereunto were ye called: because



Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:
